

# Great Ocean Road Tour (1 day)

Time (min)	Place	Comment
45	Surf Coast Beach	<b>(away from other buses).</b> Beautiful sandy beach Great place for morning tea and a beach walk. Toilets available
10	Memorial Arch	3000 WW1 soldiers built the Great Ocean Road in the 1920's. Take a photo and read about their story at the monument. Also a nice little beach for a photo op.
10	Special Lookout	<b>(away from other buses).</b> Possibly the best view of the road itself. Oh and the ocean looks fantastic as well!
30	Koalas	<b>(away from other buses).</b> Find at least 5 koalas in the wild. Walk up the road at your own pace. The bus will return in around 15 minutes after turning around.
50	Lunch Apollo Bay	Enjoy lunch at a café in Apollo Bay with a good range of meal options (included)
30	Otway Rainforest	Mait's Rest in the rainforest. A wonderful 30 min loop walk takes you to a different world. No toilets
45	12 Apostles	Enjoy the wonderful 12 Apostles (there are only 8!). Take your time. Toilets and café available
35	Loch Ard Gorge	A beautiful gorge with steps down to the beach. Take your shoes off, feel the water on your feet. Look around you from the base of the Gorge.
10	London Bridge	The perfect spot to say farewell to the Great Ocean Road
5	Port Campbell	Toilet stop before turning for home.
20	Colac dinner stop	Macdonalds, KFC, Red Rooster or Subway. You can eat in if you order quickly or eat on the bus. If you bring drinks on the bus please make sure that you finish them.

**Unique features of our one day tour:**

1. 3 stops away from the other buses. (Experience, local knowledge, small groups and a little extra time and care allow us to do this.
2. 25% more time off the bus exploring tourist areas than many other guides will give you.
3. 3 stops of 45+ minutes (exceptions may occur if heavy rain)
4. Our rock pool ramble on a good day is unique to our tours.
5. Every tour in good weather provides the opportunity for a swim so bring your bathers and towel on a nice day. (This is also unique to our one day tours)
6. Your guide!
7. We will give you a written itinerary and map on the day of the tour.

**Things to bring:**

Bring warm clothes. If the forecast is warm then you can wear shorts and t shirts but we highly recommend throwing in a jumper and wind resistant jacket. There are often multiple weather patterns down there. Sunscreen and a bottle of water are also a good idea. Just repeating the wind can be strong and cold in parts of the ocean road. Make sure you are warm enough! In warm weather bring something for swimming and a towel if interested.
